Credit Transfer

“Credit transfer” means allowing a student of another university to get admitted to OSOU for completing any similar or related Post Graduate Degree Programmes on the basis of credits obtained by him from parent University/Institutions. A student thus admitted need not appear OSOU examinations relating to such courses/papers, which are considered equivalent to and for which appropriate credits would be deemed to have been acquired.

External Credit Transfer Scheme

Eligibility

The credit transfer scheme is applicable only to those candidates who have completed their Post Graduate Diploma or Higher Degree from any recognized university but are willing to complete a Master Degree through OSOU as per rules provided.

Modalities

- i) Normally credit transfer will be applicable only from a Post Graduate Diploma or Higher Degree to a Master Degree Programme.
- ii) As per credit transfer rules, once the admission is confirmed by the University and after the allotment of Enrollment number, a learner can apply for credit transfer in respect of the courses completed from the accredited universities/ institutions.
- iii) Credit transfer will be permissible in the case of students coming from institutions established by an Act of Parliament or by an Act of State Legislature, or an institution “Deemed to be University”, or an “Institution of National Importance”, or institutions recognized by statutory bodies.
- iv) Credit transfer can be done only on the basis of individual courses and not on the basis of year to year courses.
- v) In order to get a degree from OSOU, **a student will be required to earn at least 50% credits from OSOU**. For example, an **MJMC student should earn at least 32 credits out of 64 credits** from OSOU for OSOU degree in minimum (One) 01 year of Duration.

Rules and Regulations

- i) Enrolled learners who want to avail of credit transfer shall fill a prescribed online form from with the attachment of necessary documentation as below.
 - a) Programme Fees of One Year payable Online
 - b) Mark Sheet(s), for the programme and
 - c) Syllabus of programme/courses covered by them.
 - d) Evaluation Methodology of the concerned Programme/Course
 - e) Eligibility Criteria
- ii) After submitting the online form, it will be examined separately by the Equivalence Committee of the University and Credit transfer confirmation will be intimated to the concerned Candidate. **This process will take a minimum period of one month from the last date of submission of the online form with all the relevant documents.**
