Welcome to Odisha State Open University, Sambalpur.


University Grants Commission (UGC) has given approval to OSOU to offer 26 Bachelor's and Master's degree programme from the academic session 2018-19. UGC approval is for the next five years. This is a great achievement considering the fact that the University is established in 2015 and has completed just three years in last June. We are planning to offer only eleven programmes at the Master's Degree level from the current academic year. For undergraduate programmes it has been decided to follow common curriculum by all state funded universities in Odisha from the next academic session.

Master's degree programmes will be offered mostly in autonomous colleges where similar teaching facilities are available. Our emphasis will be on quality aspects of the programme delivery and student support services. Norms prescribed by UGC for conduct of counseling sessions and number of assignments per course shall be strictly followed. In programmes like Political Science, History, Sociology, Public Administration materials prepared by IGNOU in english shall be provided to you. But, you will be allowed to write assignments and appear in term-end examination in either english or odia language.

During the course of study you will be exposed to technology supported learning methods. E-library facilities shall be made available. E-content shall be uploaded on the OSOU web portal. Important information shall be communicated to you either through SMS or through other social media.

### **UNIVERSITY PROFILE**

The Odisha State Open University is established by an Act of the State Legislature in 2015. The University has jurisdiction over the entire State of Odisha. The mandate is on education, research, training and capacity building by diversity on means of distance and continuing education including the use of new educational technology available to common man at affordable cost. Degrees, Diplomas and Certificates issued by the University shall be treated at par with Degrees/Diplomas issued by other Universities established by centre/states and recognized by UGC. Emphasis is placed on Skill Based Education to enhance employability of the students. To fulfill its mandate the Open University has established Regional Centers and Study Centers in different parts of the State. Besides Under Graduate, Post- Graduate, Skill Based and vocational courses, focus is on Journalism & Mass Communication, Business & Management Studies, Computer Science courses, Rural Development, Disaster Management, Communication Skills, Translation Studies and functional aspects of Odia and Hindi language courses. Add-on courses are on offer targeting students already admitted in Undergraduate courses in the State. The fee to be charged from the students has been made reasonable and affordable by disadvantaged groups. All Norms and Regulations prescribed by UGC and other Statutory Bodies are strictly followed in offering academic programmes by the Odisha State Open University.

### **MANDATE OF THE UNIVERSITY**

To provide an innovative system of university level education, flexible and open with regard to methods and pace of learning, course choice, entry requirements and evaluation strategies with a view to promote learning and encourage excellence in new fields of knowledge with skill training, thereby contributing to the development of the State.

### **UNIVERSITY MANAGEMENT**

The Governor of Odisha is the **Chancellor** of the University. By virtue of his office the Chancellor is the head of the University. He enjoys the power to appoint the Vice-Chancellor, to preside over the convocations of the University and to cause an inspection/inquiry of any matter connected with administration and finances of the University.

The **Board of Management** is the Chief Executive Body of the University. It has the power of management and administration of the revenue and property of the University; to effect standardization of skill-related education available in the State; to manage and regulate the finances, accounts and investment of the property of the University; to create teaching, other academic, administrative and ministerial posts and to prescribe the functions and conditions of services of the employee; to institute fellowship, scholarships and studentships.

The **Academic Council** is the principal academic body to co-ordinate and exercise general supervision over the academic policies of the University. It is responsible for maintaining the academic standards.

**Skill Development Education Council** has to organize and promote skill related trainings and programmes; to give recognition to industries, firms, institutions, different registered workshops, laboratories, training institutes as training platform for students of the University, to work out the modalities to standardize vocational and skill development education offered by different organizations and to withhold recognition of defaulting bodies.

The **Planning Board** is the principal planning body responsible for monitoring of the developments on the lines indicated in the objects of the University.

The **Board of Recognition** is responsible for admitting Government recognized colleges to the privileges of the University for providing add-on and skill development courses.

The **Finance Committee** shall deal with the financial matters of the University including investment of University funds and purchase of any immovable property.

### **REGIONAL CENTRES AND STUDY CENTRES**

Open University in Odisha has established Regional Centres and Study Centres in different parts of the State to provide student support services. Skill Development Centres are established for hands-on training. During the last three years University has established study centres in all 30 districts in Odisha. All centres have been established in reputed Universities and Government/Aided Colleges. Regional Centres have been established at Bhubaneswar, Berhampur, Jeypore and Balasore. Detailed list of Study Centres already established in different parts of Odisha has been given in Annexure- 1.

### **CREDIT SYSTEM**

Odisha State Open University is following credit system where each credit is equivalent to 30 hours of study. For any certificate level course of six month duration students are required to earn 16 credits(480 Study Hours) and for a diploma course of one year duration the minimum credit required for successful completion of programme will be 32 credits(960 Study Hours). Post Graduate Diploma Programme are eighteen months duration. Credit value of PG Diploma is 48 (1440 Study Hours). Under graduate Degree Programmes will be of three years duration and credit value will range from 96-128 (2880-3840) Study Hours. Post Graduate Degree

Programmes will be of two years and the credit value will range from 64-72 (1920-2160 Hours).

### **SEMESTER SYSTEM**

Open University is following semester system. Each semester is of six months duration. The performance of the students is evaluated after the end of each semester. Academic Calendar is available on the University web portal.

### **GRADING SYSTEM**

State Open University in Odishais following grading system of evaluation to assess the performance of the students. Ten point grading system suggested by the University Grants Commission (UGC) is implemented by the University. Semester grade point average (SGPA) and cumulative grade point average (CGPA) are reflected in the Grade Card of the students along with percentage of marks with division secures.

### **EVALUATION SYSTEM**

Evaluation system is based on two core components: continuous evaluation and term-end examination. Continuous evaluation carries 25% weightage and the end semester examination carries 75% weightage. In skill based programmes with hands-on training evaluation of the performance of students in practical and theory have a ratio of 75:25. Some programmes have project component. Evaluation in project courses have two aspects, project report and viva voce which is in the ratio of 75:25. University will offer some non-credit courses to create awareness for which a certificate of participation will be issued.

## **1.MASTER OF ARTS ENGLISH (MAEG)**

### **Programme objectives:**

- To impart post graduate-level education in english literature so as to enhance the ability to use current theoretical approaches to literary study.
- To provide advanced English literature and knowledge, perspectives and skills to a wide cross section of learners, including those in remote and inaccessible area of the state.
- To synthesize learners for a wide understanding of literary characteristics, themes, and/or approaches in several literary texts.
- To give the learners a sound understanding of English and American literatures and also other new areas in literature such as, Canadian, Australian and Indian English.
- The pre-requisite of the programme is to equip learners with a good knowledge of reading, comprehension and writing skills

### **Programme outcomes:**

After completing the course: ,

- Learner will have fair understanding detailing the development and current practices of literary studies, rhetoric etc
- Will be able to describe rhetoric contextually and comparatively and/or to historicize and theorize emerging forms of composition and expression.
- Will demonstrate critical and analytical skills in the interpretation and evaluation of literary texts.
- A learner will have the ability to demonstrate command over written english, including the abilities to organize and present material proficiently.
- Students will gain further research, writing, and analytical skills

to be utilized in their future professional and academic endeavors.

- Students will have career opportunities in Journalism, Interpreter, Advertising, Instructional Designing, Linguistics, Editors.

### **Programme outcomes:**

- Will be able to provide evidence of sophisticated awareness of the interrelationship of the human experience and historical perspective.

- A learner will have the ability to construct original historical arguments based on primary source material for research.

### **University Rules and Guidelines**

**1. FEES:**

*Fee will be paid annually. First Year fees will be collected at the time of admission. Second Year fees is to be paid during the month of May 2019.*

**2. EXAMINATION:**

*Examination will be conducted on semester basis.*

**3. LATERAL ENTRY STUDENTS:**

*A new scheme for lateral entry for students in Journalism, Rural-Development, Cyber-Security will be announced by the University in due course of time. Students having a Post Graduate Diploma in the above disciplines from other Universities/Institutions shall be covered through the new scheme. The scheme will be made effective from the July 2019 session.*

**4. ASSIGNMENTS:**

*There shall be two assignment for four to eight credits course, and one assignments for each course with less than four credit. Dates of submission of assignments will be duly notified in the University website.*

**5. ADMISSION IN MORE THAN ONE PROGRAMME:**

*Students are allowed to take admission in only one Master Degree Programme at a time. In case anybody is found to have taken admission in more than one programme both shall be treated as cancelled and fee shall not be refunded. However students are allowed to take admission in any*



*Certificate/Diploma programme along with the Master Degree Programme, in the same academic session.*

**6. CHANGE OF PROGRAMME:**

*Change of Programme is permitted before the commencement of the academic session on 15<sup>th</sup> of February. In case the student want to change the programme after this date they shall have to pay the full programme fees for the new programme and the programme for which fees have been already paid shall not be refunded*

**7. EXAMINATION CENTRE:**

*Examination shall be conducted in those centre where the programme is activated. Students are allowed to change the study centre in case the centre is activated for the programme and examination for that programme is conducted in the centre.*

**8. MEDIUM OF STUDY**

*Medium of study will be English and Odia. Study material for Programme like History, Public-Administration, Political Science, Sociology will be provided with material in English. However they will be allowed to write assignments and appear in the Term End Examination in either English or Odia as per their choice. In programmes like Journalism & Mass Communication and Rural Development study materials will be provide in Odia & English and medium of examination will be both in English and Odia.*
