Programme Description:

The goal of this programme is to explore fundamental techniques in Photoshop. Ideal for students eager to explore Photoshop, work with layer techniques, gain an understanding of how to do basic photo repairs and color enhancements.

Learning Objectives

- ✓ Learn how to make use of more advanced features that will make your Photographs pieces of art.

Learning Outcomes:

Students will gain a working knowledge of Photoshop and develop their skills in editing and altering photographs for through a basic understanding of the PS toolbar, layers, and the adjustments panel. This course will take a look at the basic yet powerful features of Photoshop.

Upon completion of the course students will have the knowledge and ability to use Photoshop confidently and effectively. Among other uses the student will have employed Photoshop creatively to create four real world production challenges for print, photography, web and video.
